

Activities for The room on the broom

- Have a think about a spell you could make if you met the witch from the story. Explain to a grown up what your spell would do and what ingredients you would need to create it.
- Draw your own cauldron (pause the story for an example) and draw all the ingredients that you might use for your spell. Label the objects by writing all the sounds you can hear in the word next to them.
- Try writing the word 'broom' by listening to all the sounds you can hear in the word.
- Create your own broom by tracing your hand with a pencil around a piece of paper and then cutting it out. You can even make the characters that were friends with the witch to sit on your broom.
- Brainstorm what materials you would use to fix a broken broom. What material would be best?
- If you have a broom at home, find objects around the house that are longer and shorter than it.
