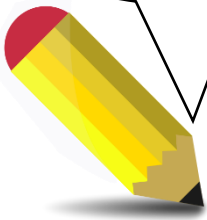


Year 2 Suggested Remote Learning Schedule

Writing

Perhaps you might like to keep a daily journal and write about something that excites or interests you each day...



15 minutes of writing activities daily

Choose from the following...

- ❖ Login in to SeeSaw and pick a writing activity to complete from the Grade 2 Literacy Matrix.



- ❖ Free writing! You could write your own story or write about a book you have read. Write about an activity you have done with your family.
- ❖ Practise your neatest handwriting in your lined book by writing the alphabet from a to z, you could even try it backwards!

10 minutes of spelling or grammar and punctuation activities daily.

- ❖ Login to SeeSaw and pick a spelling or punctuation and grammar activity from the Grade 2 Literacy Matrix.
- ❖ Practise spelling any of the Oxford Words that you find tricky or difficult words you come across when reading. Look for different ways to practise such as rainbow writing or tracing in shaving cream!



Please remember that the activities and times are suggestions. There are plenty of opportunities that arise each day where writing skills can be practised. For example, **write** a lovely letter to your neighbours or get outside and **write** a message in chalk for all to read! Help your very busy parents out by **writing** down the shopping list.
