If you go for a walk or a ride with your family have a look at the numbers on the letterboxes, are they odd or even?

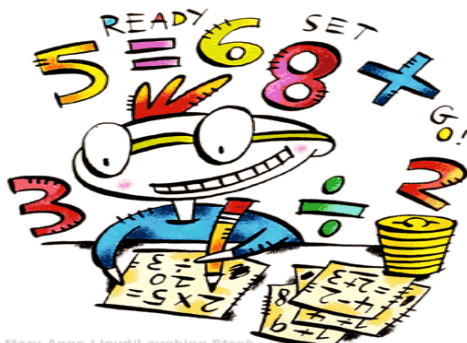


40 minutes of maths activities daily

- ❖ Log in to SeeSaw and choose 1-2 activities to complete from the **Grade 2 Maths Matrix**.
- ❖ Pick a number from 0 - 999 and count forward or back from that number, writing the numbers down in your book as you go. Challenge yourself by skip counting by 2's, 3's, 4's, 5's or 10's from different starting numbers.
- ❖ Challenge your problem solving skills by logging in to Prodigy. (Log in details included in your care pack).



Please remember that the activities and times are suggestions. There are plenty of opportunities that arise each day where maths skills can be practised. For example, **count** how many pieces of lego you have used while building. **Measure** how much of each ingredient you need when helping to cook dinner.



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
